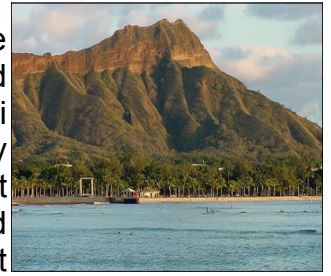

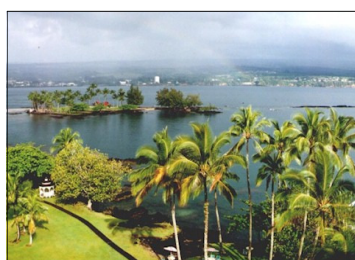

**Kahului, Maui** - A surplus of natural splendor and the genuine hospitality of its people have helped to make Maui Hawaii's second most popular island. Explore the fascinating history of the town of Lahaina. Picnic at a nearby plantation, plant yourself on a pristine beach or play one of the world's most beautiful golf courses, or hit the world-renowned links at nearby Kapalua. Kahului is a bustling harbor, yet just minutes away are some of this island's most scenic spots. Visit the Sacred Lao Valley and the Maui Tropical Plantation.

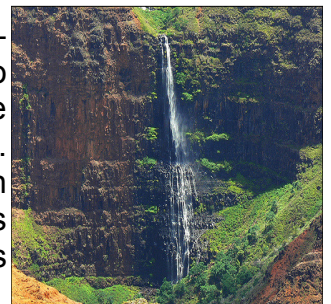

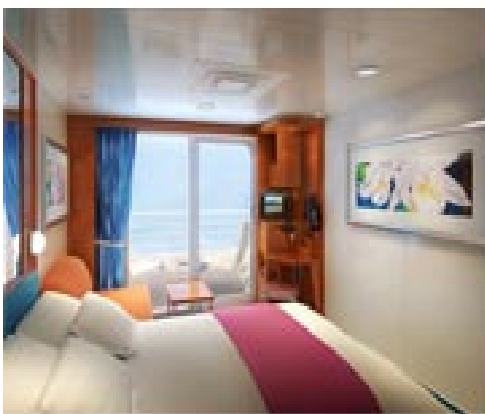
### IA ~ Interior Stateroom

### BA ~ Balcony Cabin

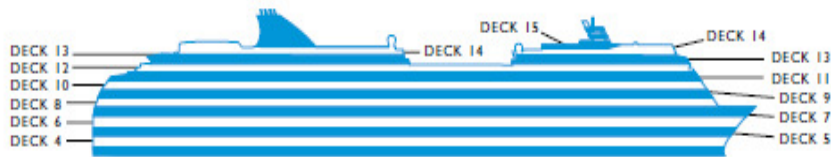

**Weather:** In the winter in Hawaii, expect temperatures in the day at 70's and 80' in the evening mid 60's. This also is prime whale watching season!

**Dining:** On the Pride of America, all dining is open. You may eat at whatever time you please. You may eat in the main dining room or any of the specialty restaurants (some have cover charges).

**Clothing:** You may dress as you please. This is a casual cruise, casual attire is appropriate for this trip. Bathing suits, and tank tops, are not allowed in the restaurants for dinner. There is one optional evening for a more formal attire (Dark suits and ties are recommended for the gentleman and a dressy dress is great for the ladies.) for picture taking, etc. if you wish to participate.

**Documentation:** No passport needed for travel to Hawaii. You have the option of using either your driver's license or valid passport as proper documentation. New regulations require your airline ticket and cruise documents match which ever ID you will be using. If they do not match you could be denied boarding.

**Deposit and Final Payment:** An initial deposit of \$500.00 per person with the optional insurance plus the CEU fees are due at time of booking. A second deposit of \$1,000.00 is due on or before September 5, 2012. Final payment is due on or before November 1, 2012.

**Cancellation:** Cancellations made after initial deposit will be subject to a cancellation handling fee of \$100.00 per person. Cancellations made after November 1, 2012 are nonrefundable.
